

BayREN implements effective energy saving programs on a regional level and draws on the expertise, experience, and proven track record of Bay Area local governments to develop and administer successful climate, resource, and sustainability programs.

SINGLE FAMILY

BayREN is the exclusive administrator of Energy Upgrade California® Home Upgrade and the Advanced Home Upgrade Assessment Incentive for single family homeowners in the Bay Area. BayREN provides rebates of up to \$3,000 for Home Upgrade and \$300 for homeowners who have completed an energy assessment through the utility-administered Advanced program. BayREN also offers a Home Upgrade Advisor Service which provides free technical and one-on-one assistance to home owners and contractors.





Seven regional forums were held that focused on policy and program design issues and energy code compliance.


MULTIFAMILY

The BayREN Multifamily program offers property owners free technical assistance and rebates of \$750 per unit for saving 10% or more of their whole building’s energy usage. The program has been extremely popular, and has exceeded its unit goals for technical assistance and rebate reservations. To date, 999 units have completed, receiving \$749,250 in rebates.



PAYS® On-Water Bill Program

The BayREN PAYS Program partners with Bay Area municipal water utilities to implement on-bill financing programs for water and energy efficient measures. Participants pay for installed measures through a regular surcharge attached to their meter, with the assurance that their utility bill savings will exceed the surcharge. BayREN PAYS currently is working with three Bay Area water utilities that serve almost 1.5 million residents.
