


BayREN is a collaboration of the 9 counties that make up the San Francisco Bay Area. BayREN implements effective energy saving programs on a regional level and draws on the expertise, experience, and proven track record of Bay Area local governments to develop and administer successful climate, resource, and sustainability programs.

## SINGLE FAMILY

BayREN is the exclusive administrator of Energy Upgrade California® Home Upgrade and the Advanced Home Upgrade Assessment Incentive for single family homeowners in the Bay Area. BayREN provides rebates of up to \$3,000 for Home Upgrade and \$300 for homeowners who have completed an energy assessment through the utility-administered Advanced program. BayREN also offers a Home Upgrade Advisor Service which provides free technical and one-on-one assistance to home owners and contractors.

**Compliance Improvement**

C&S activities are designed to enhance energy code compliance processes in building departments and promote regional best practices. Expanding upon the Permit Resource Opportunity Program work from 2014/2015, 2016 Compliance Improvement activities will focus on tools and resources that increase building departments' understanding of how to improve code compliance and enforcement in a streamlined manner.

**Trainings**




Trainings are intended for both local officials and the private sector building community members interested in learning about new energy code development and best practices to improve code compliance and enforcement. Over 550 local building department staff have been trained to date.

**Regional Forums**


Regional Forums are workshops targeting elected officials, local building department Chief Building Officials, and regional C&S advocates to share best practices on how to resolve regional policy and programmatic design issues. The March Regional Forum had 57 attendees. The June Forum will be held at the CSU, East Bay Oakland Center in Oakland, CA on June 22, 2016 and will focus on 2016 Energy Code updates.

**MULTIFAMILY**

The BayREN Multifamily program offers property owners free technical assistance and rebates of \$750 per unit for saving 15% or more of their whole building's energy usage. The program is extremely popular, and to date, 15,896 units have completed, receiving \$11,921,172 in rebates.
