


BayREN is a collaboration of the 9 counties that make up the San Francisco Bay Area. BayREN implements effective energy saving programs on a regional level and draws on the expertise, experience, and proven track record of Bay Area local governments to develop and administer successful climate, resource, and sustainability programs.

SINGLE FAMILY

BayREN is the exclusive administrator of Energy Upgrade California® Home Upgrade and the Advanced Home Upgrade Assessment Incentive for single family homeowners in the Bay Area. BayREN provides rebates of up to \$3,000 for Home Upgrade and \$300 for homeowners who have completed an energy assessment through the utility-administered Advanced program. BayREN also offers a Home Upgrade Advisor Service which provides free technical and one-on-one assistance to home owners and contractors.


CODES & STANDARDS



Energy code trainings are designed to provide the building community with practical implementation strategies for code compliance and enforcement. Over 750 local building department staff has been trained across the bay area region.

Permit Resource Opportunity Program (PROP)

The PROP is designed to enhance energy code compliance processes in building departments and establish regional compliance baselines and best practices. BayREN released the PROP Final Report and Resource Guide on 2014 activities in April. 2015 PROP Visits will build upon the work started in 2014 to provide participating building departments with up to two days of energy code training and support at department offices and in the field.




Forums focus on policy and program design issues and energy code compliance. Seven regional forums were held in 2014, and six forums are planned for 2015. The forum held on August 25 in Santa Clara County had 40 attendees.

MULTIFAMILY

The BayREN Multifamily program offers property owners free technical assistance and rebates of \$750 per unit for saving 10% or more of their whole building’s energy usage. The program is extremely popular, and is on target to meet its unit goals for technical assistance and rebate reservations for 2015. To date, 9,068 units have completed, receiving \$6,800,172 in rebates.



Units in the Pipeline
